Notice of the Wallumbilla Demand Zone on the Natural Gas Services Bulletin Board

This Notice is to advise that the addition of the Wallumbilla Demand Zone and the amendment to the SWQP Demand Zone will be effective on the Natural Gas Services Bulletin Board (GGB) on 1 June 2016.

In accordance with Schedule 2 of the BB Procedures (version 6), the Wallumbilla Demand Zone is described as net flows into or out of the SWQP compound located at Wallumbilla including those from the RBP, QGP, SWQP, Berwyndale to Wallumbilla Pipeline (BWP), Darling Downs Pipeline (DDP), Comet Ridge to Wallumbilla Pipeline including Fairview (CRWP), and Spring Gully Pipeline (SGP).

The Wallumbilla Demand Zone will become an operational demand zone from the beginning of the gas day commencing on 1 June 2016. Pipelines delivering gas to and receiving gas from the Wallumbilla Demand Zone must make submissions and provide information required from 1 June 2016, by the times and in the manner required under Part 18 of the National Gas Rules.

The information required for BB Pipelines is:

Linepack Capacity Adequacy Flag	2 June 2016
Capacity Outlook	2 June 2016
Delivery Nominations	2 June 2016
Actual Flow	1 June 2016

From the beginning of the gas day commencing on 1 June 2016, the gas flows for SWQP demand zone ID 540023 will no longer include deliveries to (or from) Berwyndale (BWP) and Comet Ridge (CRWP) pipelines.
